Shift Description:

- This is a full-time position with hours varying between 35-40 hours per week.
- Typical schedule for Program Assistant (PA) with AM Route- 7:15 am-3:00 pm
- Typical schedule for Program Assistant (PA) with PM Route- 9:00 am-4:45 pm
- Depending on candidate's experience and company needs this position may or may not include an AM or PM driving route.

Job Duties:

- Provide safe and efficient morning and afternoon transportation for individuals with disabilities to the Adult Day Services programs-training provided.
- Engage individuals with disabilities in small group volunteer activities in the community
- Teach small group classes such as, cooking, daily living skills, art, nutrition, community resources etc. All class supplies provided by BRIDGE for Community Life Inc.
- Assist with personal cares- training provided
